**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD  
(SHIELDS ROAD PELAW)  
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2007**

The Borough Council of Gateshead ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all the other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

**Part I  
General**

**Interpretation**

- 1 In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

**"disabled person's badge"** has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000

**"disabled person's vehicle"** has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

**"disabled person's parking disc"** means a disc issued by a local authority (125 millimetres square) coloured blue if issued on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April 2000 or orange if issued before that date and is capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting has begun: and –

**"relevant position"** means –

- (a) the disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge is exhibited on the dashboard of fascia of the vehicle; or
- (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle;

so that the front of the disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.

A vehicle displays a disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge in the relevant position if –

- (c) the disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge is exhibited on the dashboard of fascia of the vehicle; or
- (d) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle

**"universal service provider"** has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000

## **Part II**

### **Waiting Restrictions**

#### **Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time**

- 2** Save as provided in Article 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable or of a traffic warden in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the north side of Shields Road Pelaw for a distance of 12 metres in an easterly direction from a point 61 metres east of its junction with Duke Street
- 3** (1) Nothing in Articles 2, 5 and 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable
- (a) the picking up and setting down of passengers;
  - (b) goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
    - (i) building or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the said roads;
    - (iv) the laying erection alteration or maintenance in or in land adjacent to the said lengths of roads of any sewer, main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (d) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory duties;
  - (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets in the service of a universal service provider
- (2) Nothing in Articles 2, 5 and 6 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes.
- (3) Nothing in Articles 2, 5 and 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit the following vehicles to wait:-
- (a) a hackney carriage (as defined in the Town Police Clauses Act 1847) waiting at a duly authorised cab rank;
  - (b) a vehicle waiting on a parking place duly authorised by an Order made under the Act provided that the vehicle is parked in accordance with the provisions of such an Order.

- 4 Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a disabled person's parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the lengths of road referred to therein for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road on the same day).

**Prohibition of Waiting between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm**

- 5 Save as provided in Article 3 and 7 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm in or on the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

**Limited Waiting - Twenty Minutes in any One Hour between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm (Monday - Saturday)**

- 6 Save as provided in Article 3 and 7 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm Monday to Saturday (inclusive) the north side of Shields Road Pelaw for a distance of 50 metres in an easterly direction from a point 11 metres east of its junction with Duke Street
- (a) for a longer period than twenty minutes
  - (b) if a period of less than forty minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on the same length of road
- 7 Nothing in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait in the length of road referred to therein.
- 8 The restrictions and prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment
- 9 This Order shall come into operation on 14 May 2007 and may be cited as the Borough Council of Gateshead (Shields Road Pelaw)(Waiting Restrictions) Order 2007

**Schedule**  
**Prohibition of Waiting between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm**

Shields Road – south side from its junction with Portland Street to its junction with Fisherwell Road.

Shields Road – north side from a point 4.7 metres west of its junction with Salisbury Street to a point 11.0 metres east of its junction with Duke Street.

Shields Road – north side from a point 73.0m east of its junction with Duke Street to its junction with Fisherwell Road.

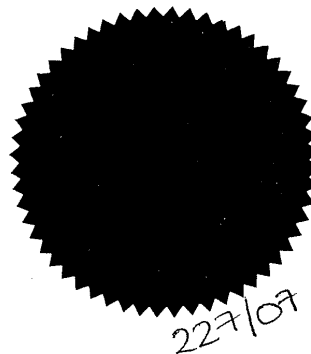
- i. Cartmel Park – both sides from its junction with Shields Road for a distance of 15.5 metres in a southerly direction.

Access to car park (Aldi) – both sides from its junction with Shields Road for a distance of 10.0 metres in a southerly direction.
