

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90C (GLENRIDDING CLOSE, GATESHEAD) PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 and after consultation and in accordance with Section 90C of the Highways Act 1980 proposes to construct road humps complying with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 as a traffic calming measure in order to reduce vehicle speed.

The proposal consists of introducing:

- a) One pair of speed cushions with a height of 75mm and a width of 1.9m and length of 3m and a 700mm drainage channel either side of the carriageway at the locations specified in Schedule 1 below;

The current speed limit on the lengths of road is 30mph until the proposed 20mph speed limit zone is brought into effect.

There are no additional works or traffic calming features to be undertaken. Signs will be erected and road markings provided in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 at all appropriate locations.
