

**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD
(WHICKHAM HIGHWAY, GATESHEAD)(WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2021**

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead (“hereinafter referred to as the Council”) proposes to make an order in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 45, 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended and by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 (“the 2004 Act”) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act.

The proposed order will introduce a prohibition of waiting at any time and a prohibition of loading at any time along the lengths of road set out in the Schedule below.

1.	Whickham Highway (B6317)	(i) south west	(a) from a point 11 metres north west of its junction with Lobley Hill Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 222 metres.
		(ii) north east	(a) from a point 11 metres north west of its junction with Lobley Hill Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 109 metres.
2.	Malvern Gardens	(i) both	(a) From its junction with Whickham Highway in a south-easterly direction to the access into Immaculate Heart of Mary Church approximately 16 metres inclusive of junctions.
