THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD (FOLLINGSBY LANE, GATESHEAD) (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2021

Statement of Reasons

Following the new development and realignment of Follingsby Lane and as part of the Councils commitment to improve road safety and visibility, No waiting and No Loading restrictions are proposed along Follingsby Lane and a prohibition of Right Turn and Left Turn and also speed restrictions. It is also proposed to introduce No Waiting restrictions within the Park to aid accessibility and to address inconsiderate parking within the area causing obstructions.

Gateshead Council as Highway Authority propose to make the above order in discharge of its duty under Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, "to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic (including pedestrians)", in accordance with the provisions of Section 1(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 namely:-

(a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;



(b) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
