**DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT**  
**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD (FOOTPATH LAMESLEY 33)**  
**DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2022**

The above order, made on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2022, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by upgrading to a Bridleway the public right of way Footpath Lamesley 33. From Moormill Lane, point A on the order map, Grid Reference NZ24855680, Footpath Lamesley 33 proceeds in a southerly direction crossing over Bridleway Lamesley 72a and continues in a southerly direction to the edge of Beggardene Wood, point B on the order map, Grid Reference NZ24865572. It is approximately 1036 metres in length with a width of 3 metres.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Borough Council of Gateshead, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State may itself confirm the order. If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
