

**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD
(WHICKHAM HIGHWAY, GATESHEAD)
(WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022**

Notice is hereby given that on the 23 November 2022 the Borough Council of Gateshead (“hereinafter referred to as the Council”) made an order in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended and by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 (“the 2004 Act”) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act.

This Order, which comes into effect on the 28 November 2022, replaces the earlier order made on the 12 January 2022 and introduces the prohibition of waiting at any time and a prohibition of loading at any time along the lengths of road set out in the Schedule below.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under them has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.

1.	Whickham Highway (B6317)	(i) south west	(a) from a point 11 metres north west of its junction with Lobley Hill Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 222 metres.
		(ii) north east	(a) from a point 11 metres north west of its junction with Lobley Hill Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 109 metres.
2.	Malvern Gardens	(i) both	(a) From its junction with Whickham Highway in a south-easterly direction to the access into Immaculate Heart of Mary Church approximately 16 metres inclusive of junctions.
