THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD (BRIDLEWAY WHICKHAM 62) & (FOOTPATH WHICKHAM 194)

(DERWENT COUNTRY PARK)

PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2023

This Order is made by the Borough Council of Gateshead ('the authority') under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that the bridleway and footpath as described in the Schedule to this Order are not needed for public use as they are unsafe and inaccessible.

BY THIS ORDER

The public rights of way over land situated at Derwent Country Park and shown by the continuous bold line on the maps attached to this Order shall be extinguished after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.

SCHEDULE

- (1) Bridleway Whickham 62 running from point A grid reference NZ18636004 to point C grid reference NZ18186011 via point B grid reference NZ18235997 – the bridleway commences at the junction with the restricted byway WH/63 and proceeds south westerly, then north westerly under WH/125 to a dead end, for an overall distance of 550 metres with a width of 3 metres throughout, as shown on the order map.
- (2) Footpath Whickham 194 running from point A grid reference NZ19986211 to point B grid reference NZ19426158 – the footpath commences at Hexham Road east of Blaydon Rugby Club and just west of WH/125, it then proceeds south westerly along a track at the base of an embankment to the south corner of the rugby field, turns north west for 40 metres, then south east alongside WH/215, then turns south westerly to Dam Head, Point B for a distance of 1,200m with a width of 2 metres throughout, as shown on the order map.

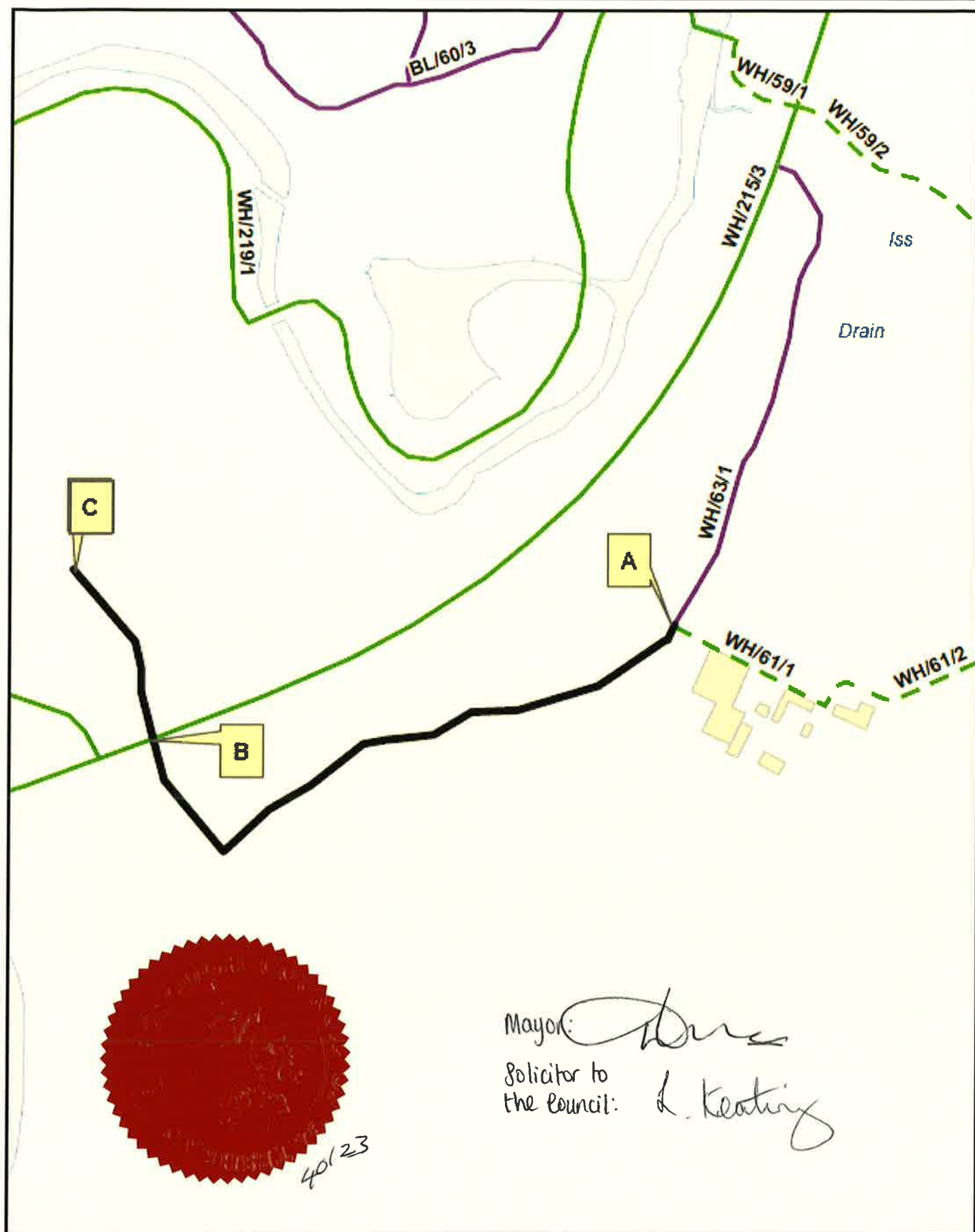

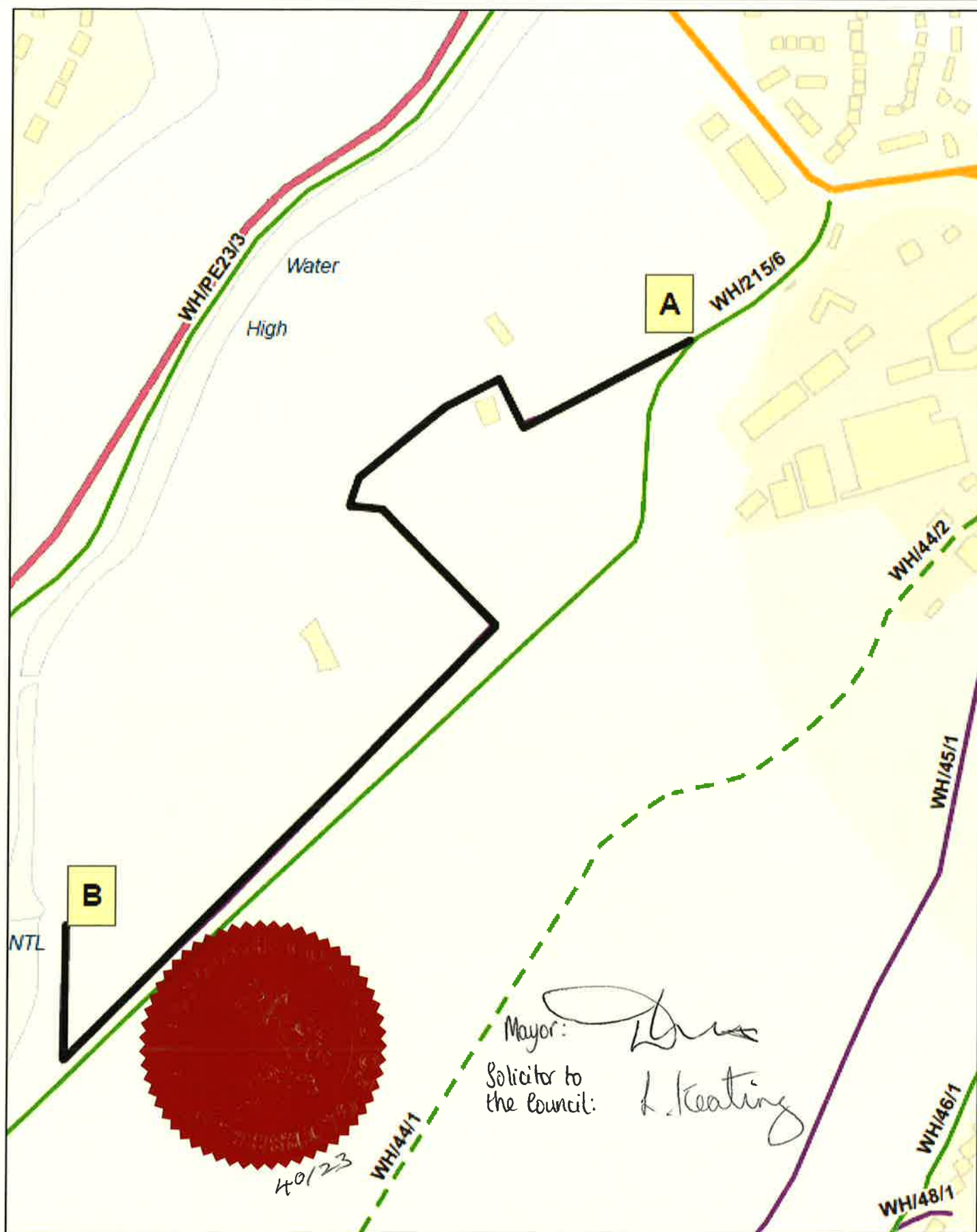
