PATH CREATION ORDER 2016**


The above order, made on 3rd November 2016 under section 26 of the Highways Act 1980, will create a public bridleway from its junction with Joel Terrace, Point A on the order map grid reference NZ29626284, Bridleway Felling 50 proceeds in an easterly direction then turns to proceed in a north easterly direction to its junction with Footpath Felling 16 at Point B on the order map grid reference NZ29946332, where it then turns easterly to Point C on the order map grid reference NZ30036340 then turns north easterly to the South Tyneside Borough Boundary at Point D on the order map grid reference NZ30046343 where it proceeds in a south westerly direction to its junction with the turning circle on Brack Terrace at Point E on the order map grid reference NZ29776271, for a distance of approximately 1508 metres, at a width of 3 metres throughout as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of the Strategic Director of Corporate Services and Governance, on the ground floor of the Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead NE8 1HH Monday to Thursday between 8.45am and 5.30pm and Friday between 8.45am and 5.00pm. Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing to the Strategic Director of Corporate Services and Governance at the above address not later than 16th December 2016. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Borough Council of Gateshead may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
