PEDESTRIAN CROSSING PROPOSAL 2024**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereby gives public notice of the proposal to establish a pedestrian traffic light controlled crossing (Toucan Crossing) along:

Lobley Hill Road – at a point 128 metres north of the junction with Swallow Tail Drive centre line.
