
**TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act.

The proposed Order will reduce the length of no waiting at any time restriction from 36 metres to 13 metres along the section of Strothers Road, High Spen, from its junction with Ramsay Street in a north westerly direction.

The draft Order together with a plan and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the information desk on the ground floor of Gateshead Council's Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead NE8 1HH, Monday to Thursday between 8.45am and 5.30pm and Friday between 8.45am and 5.00pm or online at: <http://www.gateshead.gov.uk/consultations> (Ref: TS/1081).
