**(Strothers Road, High Spen, Gateshead) (Waiting Restrictions)**

**Traffic Regulation Order 2018**

**Statement of Reasons**

Following complaints from adjoining residents and after reassessing the existing no waiting at any time restrictions along the north east section of Strothers Road, High Spen, it is proposed to reduce the length of no waiting at any time restriction (double yellow lines) from 36 metres to 13 metres in a north westerly direction, from its junction with Ramsay Street.

The reasons for this proposal are that the existing no waiting at any time restrictions were introduced because it was at that time expedient to avoid danger to persons and vehicular traffic using the road and to facilitate the safe movement of that traffic along the road, in connection with the industrial units, which have now been demolished.

Since the demolition of those industrial units it is not now considered expedient that the whole of the no waiting at any time restrictions remain in situ for the reasons above and the proposed removal of that section of no waiting at any time restriction will also provide parking to adjoining residents.
