


**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD
(HIGH VIEW ESTATE, BLAYDON, GATESHEAD) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT ZONE)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 82, 83, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act.

The proposed Order will introduce a 20mph zone in 'High View, Shibdon', along the lengths of road listed in the Schedule below.

The draft Order together with a plan and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the information desk on the ground floor of Gateshead Council's Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead NE8 1HH, Monday to Thursday between 8.45am and 5.30pm and Friday between 8.45am and 5.00pm and online at: <http://www.gateshead.gov.uk/transportconsultations> (Ref: TS/1085).

All sections of the highways as described below and their associated side and back lanes:- Dunns Way, Brantwood Court, Cheviot Close, Crowley Gardens, Hawthorn Road, Haggerstone Mews, Park Avenue, Pickering Drive, Rockmore Road, Simonside Road, Springfield Road, Tynevale Avenue, Whitewell Road, Woodvale Road, Wallington Close, Gibsons Court, Rennison Mews, Low Mill Villas, Robinsons Drive, Massey's View, Betsey Place, Dockendale Place, and Sycamore Road for their full lengths. Maple Road from the junction with Massey's View in a north easterly direction for 69 metres.
