

**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD  
(A694 BLAYDON, GATESHEAD) (SPEED LIMIT REVIEW) TRAFFIC  
REGULATION ORDER 2016**


**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 82, 83, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act.

The proposed Order will reduce the existing section of:

1. 50mph speed limit on the A694 Spa Well Road to 40mph;
2. 40mph speed limit on A694 Spa Well Road / A694 Lockhaugh Road to 30mph;
3. National speed limit on A694 Lockhaugh Road to 40mph;
4. 40mph on A694 Lockhaugh Road to 30mph;
5. National speed limit on the section of A694 Lintzford Road to 40mph.

The draft Order together with a plan and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the information desk on the ground floor of Gateshead Council's Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead NE8 1HH, Monday to Thursday between 8.45am and 5.30pm and Friday between 8.45am and 5.00pm and online at: <http://www.gateshead.gov.uk/consultation> (Ref: TH/1646).
