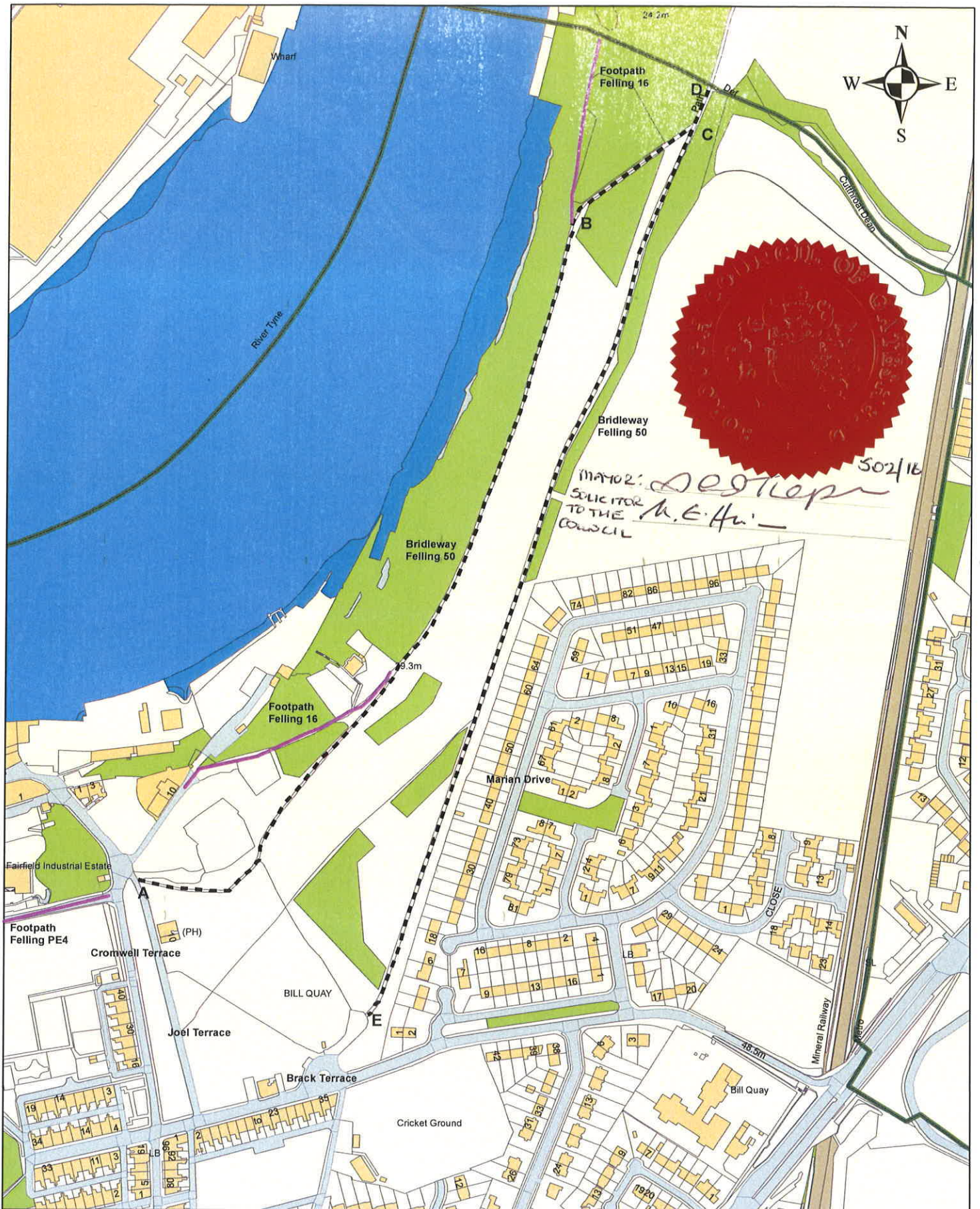

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD (BRIDLEWAY FELLING 50) PUBLIC PATH CREATION ORDER 2016

This order is made by the Borough Council of Gateshead ('the authority') under section 26 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that, having regard to the matters set out in section 26(1), there is a need for a public bridleway over the land to which this order relates, and that it is expedient that the way should be created.

BY THIS ORDER:

There shall be from the date of confirmation of this order a public bridleway over the land at Bill Quay, Felling, described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

From its junction with Joel Terrace; Point A on the order map grid reference NZ29626284, Bridleway Felling 50 proceeds in an easterly direction then turns to proceed in a north easterly direction to its junction with Footpath Felling 16 at Point B on the order map grid reference NZ29946332, where it then turns easterly to Point C on the order map grid reference NZ30036340 then turns north easterly to the South Tyneside Borough Boundary at Point D on the order map grid reference NZ30046343 where it proceeds in a south westerly direction to its junction with the turning circle on Brack Terrace at Point E on the order map grid reference NZ29776271, for a distance of approximately 1508 metres, at a width of 3 metres throughout.
