

**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD
(ROWLANDS GILL AREA, GATESHEAD) (SPEED LIMITS) TRAFFIC REGULATION
ORDER 2017**


NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 82, 83, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act.

The proposed Order will:

1. Introduce a 20mph zone along the lengths of road listed in Schedule 1 which excludes the A694 Station Road.
2. Reduce the national speed limit to 40mph on a section of the A694 Linford Road from a point 22 metres south west of its junction with Holmewood Drive in a generally south westerly direction to the Borough boundary for a distance of 1500 metres.
