TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2017


NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act.

The proposed Order will:

- Introduce a 15 metres section of bus stop clearway on the south west side of Cyprus Crescent, 19 metres north-west of the junction with Holly Avenue.
- Extend the no waiting Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm restriction on the north side of Ellison Road by 5 metres in a north-easterly direction in front of No.9 Kensington Terrace.
- Modify the no waiting at any time restriction on the north eastern side of Wilson Street to implement a 15 metre bus stop clearway.
