

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90C (NORTH VIEW, WHICKHAM, GATESHEAD) PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF JUNCTION SPEED TABLES

NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 and after consultation and in accordance with Section 90C of the Highways Act 1980 proposes to construct two junction speed tables complying with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 as a traffic calming measure in order to reduce vehicle speed.

The proposal consists of introducing two junction speed tables with a height of 100mm, spanning the full width of the carriageway along the lengths of road listed in the Schedule below.

The current speed limit on the affected roads is 20mph.

No additional works or traffic calming features are to be undertaken. Signs will be erected and road markings provided in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 at all appropriate locations.

All details of the proposals are shown on plans, which may be inspected at the information desk on the ground floor of the Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead, NE8 1HH, Monday to Thursday between 8.45am and 5.30pm and Friday between 8.45am and 5.00pm or online at: www.gateshead.gov.uk/consultation (Ref: TH/1650).

If you wish to object to the proposal you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the above address to be received by the undersigned on or before the 28th April 2016.
