(GATESHEAD SCHOOLS) TRAFFIC REGULATION
ORDER 2016

The Borough Council of Gateshead ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all the other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

Part I
General

Interpretation

1. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"civil enforcement officer" means a person authorised by or on behalf of Gateshead Council, under Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, to supervise and enforce the road traffic contraventions for which the Council is the enforcement authority;

"parking bay" means any area within a parking place which is provided for the leaving of vehicles and is indicated by road markings compliant with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"parking place" means a place on a length of road that has been designated under this Order;

"penalty charge" and **"reduced penalty charge"** means a charge set by Gateshead Council, in accordance with the provisions of section 77 and Schedule 9 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and Regulations made thereunder and in accordance any guidance given by the Secretary of State;

"penalty charge notice" means a notice issued by a civil enforcement officer pursuant to the provisions of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and regulations made thereunder;

"prohibited area" in relation to those roads referred to in Article 3 of this Order, means all that area of a road which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1027.1 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002, as amended, and signed to Diagram 642 2A in Schedule 2 of the same Directions;

"specified hours" in relation to a prohibited area means the hours between 8.00am and 5.00pm Monday to Friday; and

"postal operator" means a person who provides the service of conveying postal packages from one place to another by post or any of the related services of receiving, collecting, sorting and delivering of such packets as defined in section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000;

"postal service" means the service of conveying postal packets from one place to another by post and the related services of receiving, collecting and delivering of such packets and any other service which relates to any of those services and is provided in conjunction with any of them as defined in section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

"disabled person's parking disc" means a disc issued by a local authority (125 millimetres square) coloured blue if issued on or after 1st April 2000 or orange if issued before that date and is capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting has begun;

"exemption certificate" means an authorisation in writing granted by the Service Director, Transport Strategy of the Council or their duly authorised representative allowing a vehicle to wait in contravention of the provisions of this Order subject to and in accordance with any specified conditions or limitations contained within that authorisation;

"postal operator" means a person who provides the service of conveying postal packets from one place to another by post or any of the related services of receiving, collecting, sorting and delivering of such packets as defined in section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000;

"relevant position" means-

- (a) the disabled person's parking disc, disabled person's badge or exemption certificate is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
- (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the disabled person's parking disc, disabled person's badge or exemption certificate is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle

so that the front of the disabled person's parking disc, disabled person's badge or exemption certificate is clearly legible from outside of the vehicle;

"vehicle" means any motor car, motor cycle and invalid carriage having the same meaning respectively as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act and any goods vehicle (being a motor vehicle not exceeding 30 unit unladen weight which is constructed or adapted for use for carriage of goods of any description.

Part II **Revocation**

1.

- (1) The Orders specified in Part I of Schedule 1 to this Order are hereby revoked.
- (2) The Orders specified in Part II of Schedule 1 to this Order are hereby revoked to the extent indicated in Column 2 of that part of the Schedule.

2.

Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait during the specified hours in any prohibited area on or in the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

3. (1) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
- (a) (i) passengers to board or alight from a school bus or
 - (ii) a school meals vehicle to load or unload
 - (iii) in either case if it is not practicable or legally possible to do so elsewhere
- (b) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
- (i) building or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the said roads;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or maintenance in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of roads of any sewer, main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (c) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory duties;
- (d) to enable a vehicle to be used by a postal operator in provision of a postal service;
- (2) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

Part IV

Amendments to the Borough Council of Gateshead (Gateshead Leisure Centre Area) (Permit and Disabled Parking Places and Traffic Regulation) Order 2013

1. The Borough Council of Gateshead (Gateshead Leisure Centre Area) (Permit and Disabled Parking Places and Traffic Regulation) Order 2013 is amended as follows:
2. In Schedule 1 'Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time' revoke item 1(b)(ii) in its entirety and replace it with the following new item 1(b)(ii) below:

"(ii) from a point 39 metres north of its junction with Back Westfield Terrace in a northerly direction for a distance of 142 metres".
3. In Schedule 1 'Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time' revoke item 8(b)(i) in its entirety and replace it with the following new item 8(b)(i) below:

"(b) south west side (i) from its junction with Whitehall Road in a south easterly direction for a distance of 23 metres".
4. In Schedule 1 'Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time', after Item 6 (a) relating to 'Whitehall Road' insert the following new Item 6 (b) below:

"(b) south east side from its junction with Alexandra Road in a south westerly direction for a distance of 19 metres".

Part V

Amendments to the Borough Council of Gateshead (Whitemere Area Gateshead) Traffic Regulation Order 2015

1. The Borough Council of Gateshead (Whitemere Area Gateshead) Traffic Regulation Order 2015 is amended as follows:
2. In the Schedule 'No Waiting at Anytime' revoke item 1(iii) in its entirety and replace it with the following new item 1(iii) below:

"(iii) north west side from its junction with Haydock Drive in a north easterly direction for 12 metres".
3. In the Schedule 'No Waiting at Anytime' after item 3 relating to 'Haydock Drive / Ashridge Court', insert the new item below:

"4. Sherburn Way (i) north east side

(a) of the western section of Sherburn Way from a point 118 metres north west of the south west kerb line of Cornforth Close in a north westerly then north easterly direction following the kerb line for 22 metres.
(b) of the western section of Sherburn Way from a point 150 metres north west of the

south west kerb line of Cornforth Close in a south easterly then north easterly direction following the kerb line for 20 metres.

(ii) both sides

(a) of the access to the school car park off the section of Sherburn Way forming the School Access Road (located 131 metres north west of the south west kerb line of Cornforth Close)

Part VI **Waiting Restrictions**

No Waiting at Any Time

1. Save as provided in Part VI Article 3 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in or on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

No Waiting between the hours of 8.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday (inclusive)

2. Save as provided in Part VI Article 3 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday (inclusive) in or on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 and in Schedule 4 to this Order.

Exemptions

3. (1) Nothing in Part VI Articles 1 and 2 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in or on the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) the picking up or setting down of passengers;
 - (b) goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations namely-
 - (i) building or demolition;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said roads;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or maintenance in or on land adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer, main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (d) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road be used in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory duties;
 - (e) to enable a vehicle to be used by a postal operator in provision of a postal service;
 - (f) any police, fire brigade or ambulance vehicle on emergency call or being used for such purposes;
 - (g) any vehicle used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (h) a vehicle waiting on a parking place duly authorised by an Order made under the Act provided that the vehicle is parked in accordance with the provisions of such an Order;
 - (i) any vehicle displaying a valid exemption certificate in the relevant position.
- (2) Nothing in Part VI Articles 1 and 2 to this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge and disabled persons parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began) to wait in the lengths of roads referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road on the same day).

Part VII

Disabled Person's Badge Parking Place Operating 24 hours on all days

1. (i) The lengths of roads specified in Column 1 of Schedule 5 to this Order are hereby designated as a parking place under section 32 of the Act, subject to the provisions in this Order, for vehicles displaying in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge, on such days and during such hours as may be specified in Columns 3 and 4 of that Schedule.
- (ii) The limits of the parking place shall be indicated by the Council on the carriageway by the appropriate traffic signs and the maximum number of parking bays within each parking place shall be as specified in Column 2 of Schedule 5.
2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer cause or permit any vehicle other than a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge to wait in or on a parking place specified in column 1 of Schedule 5 to this Order.
3. Every vehicle left in a parking place, specified in Column 1 of Schedule 5 to this Order shall:
 - (i) so stand so that every part of the vehicle is wholly within a parking place or if the parking place is so marked with parking bays, and
 - (ii) display the disabled person's badge in the relevant position and that badge remains on display during the whole period the vehicle is left to stand in the parking place or bay
4. Nothing in Part VII Article 1 to this Order shall restrict the power of the Council to close or suspend the parking place or any part thereof.

5. A police officer in uniform may suspend for not longer than twenty four hours the use of the parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension is reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.
6. Any person suspending the use of the parking place or any part thereof in accordance with Part VII Articles 4 and 5, shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to the parking place or part thereof the use of which is suspended, a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
7. For so long as a traffic sign prohibiting waiting in the parking place is displayed in accordance with Part VII Article 6 to this Order, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in that parking place or part thereof PROVIDED THAT nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait if the vehicle is left with the permission of the person suspending the parking place or part thereof in pursuance of Part VII Articles 4 and 5 to this Order, or with the permission of a police officer in uniform.

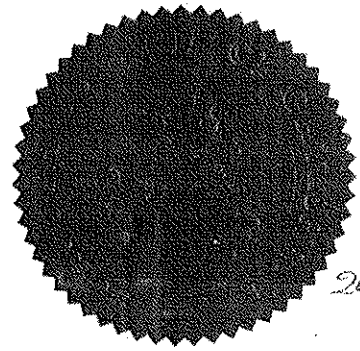
Part VIII **Commencement and Citation**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st February 2016 and may be cited as The Borough Council of Gateshead (No Stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 2016.

Part IX **Savings and Enforcement**

1. (1) The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act, or by or under any other enactment.
(2) Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, or by or under any other enactment, THEN the provisions of THIS ORDER shall prevail.
2. (1) If a vehicle is in contravention of a provision of this Order a penalty charge shall be payable.
(2) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may then be issued by a civil enforcement officer or the Council in accordance with the requirements of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004.
