

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD (WAITING, LOADING AND SPEED RESTRICTIONS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2016

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 12th April 2016 the Borough Council of Gateshead made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 82, 83, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling provisions.


The effect of the Order that comes into force on the 18th April 2016 will:

1. Prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time in Curzon Place, Gateshead, except outside the loading only period stated in the loading bay referred to in point 2 below.
2. Introduce a loading bay operating on all days between the hours of 8.00am to 8.00pm permitting loading to be carried out on the north west side of Curzon Place from a point 64 metres south west of its junction with Bottle Bank in a south westerly direction for 29 metres.
3. Incorporate Brack Terrace, Brack Terrace Back, South Parade Back and Hall Terrace in Bill Quay, Gateshead into the Bill Quay 20mph Speed Limit Zone.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under them has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
