

**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD
(DURHAM ROAD LOW FELL GATESHEAD) (NO WAITING AT ANY TIME)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2015**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act.


The effect of the proposed Order will be:

1. To prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time on the following sections of Durham Road Low Fell:
 - i. west side from a point 35 metres south of its junction with Enfield Road in a southerly direction to a point 145 metres north of its junction with The Drive
 - ii. west side from its junction with The Drive in a southerly direction to a point 94.3 metres north of its junction with Joicey Road.
2. Remove the four disabled persons blue badge holders parking bays on the west side of Durham Road located between its junction with Summerfield Road and Valley Drive.

The draft Order together with a plan and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the information desk on the ground floor of Gateshead Council's Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead, NE8 1HH, Monday to Thursday between 8.45am and 5.30pm and Friday between 8.45am and 5.00pm (Ref TH/1420).

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the above address to be received by the undersigned on or before 10 March 2015.
