

**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD (DURHAM ROAD LOW FELL
GATESHEAD) (NO WAITING AT ANY TIME) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER
2016**

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 19th April 2016 the Borough Council of Gateshead made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling provisions.


The effect of the Order that comes into force on the 25th April 2016 will:

1. Prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time on the following sections of Durham Road, Low Fell:
 - (i) west side from a point 35 metres south of its junction with Enfield Road in a southerly direction to a point 145 metres north of its junction with The Drive.
 - (ii) west side from its junction with The Drive in a southerly direction to a point 94.3 metres north of its junction with Joicey Road.
2. Remove the 4 disabled persons blue badge holders parking bays on the west side of Durham Road located between its junction with Summerfield Road and Valley Drive.

A copy of the Order together with a plan and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be examined at the information desk on ground floor of the Gateshead Council's Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead, NE8 1HH, Monday to Thursday between 8.45am and 5.30pm and Friday between 8.45am and 5.00pm or online at: www.gateshead.gov.uk/consultationspast (Ref: TH/1420).

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under them has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
