

**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD
(482 DURHAM ROAD LOW FELL GATESHEAD) (WAITING AND LOADING
RESTRICTIONS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Borough Council of Gateshead proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Northumbria Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act.


In association with the redevelopment of the former Barclays Bank to the rear of 482 Durham Road, Low Fell, the effects of the proposed Order will be to:

1. Introduce a goods vehicle only loading place to be located on the unnamed section of road adjacent to 482 Durham Road, Low Fell from the junction with Edmund Place in a northerly direction for a distance of 16 metres;
2. Remove the existing No Waiting Monday to Saturday 7.30am to 6.30pm restriction along the section of unnamed road adjacent to 482 Durham Road and Edmund Place, and
3. Introduce a 3 metre section of No Waiting at Any Time restriction on the north side of Edmund Place, 7.5 metres from the junction with Durham Road, Low Fell, Gateshead.

The draft Order together with a plan and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the information desk on the ground floor of Gateshead Council's Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead, NE8 1HH, Monday to Thursday between 8.45am and 5.30pm and Friday between 8.45am and 5.00pm or online at: <http://www.gateshead.gov.uk/consultations> (Ref TS/1050).
