**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD
(WOODSIDE LANE RYTON)
(LIMITED WAITING) ORDER 2007**

The Borough Council of Gateshead ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all the other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

Part I

General

Interpretation

- 1 In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them: -

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

"disabled person's parking disc" means a disc issued by a local authority (125 millimetres square) coloured blue if issued on or after 1st April 2000 or orange if issued before that date and is capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting has begun: and -

"relevant position" means -

- (a) the disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
- (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle;

so that the front of the disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.

A vehicle displays a disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge in the relevant position if -

- (a) the disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
- (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the disabled person's parking disc or disabled person's badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle

"universal service provider" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000

Part II

Revocation

- 2 i. The Borough Council of Gateshead (Woodside Lane) (No Waiting at Any Time) Order 2005 is hereby amended by the deletion of Item (i) of the Schedule to that Order
- ii. The Tyne and Wear County Council (The Metropolitan Borough of Gateshead Traffic Regulation (Consolidation)) Order 1982 as amended, is hereby further amended by the deletion of Item (1) of Schedule 32 to that Order

Part II

Limited Waiting - **Thirty Minutes in any One Hour between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm (Monday - Saturday)**

- 3 Save as provided in Article 4 and 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm Monday to Saturday (inclusive) on the west side of Woodside Lane from a point 27 metres west of its junction with Main Road in a south-west direction for a distance of 45 metres: -
 - (a) for a longer period than thirty minutes
 - (b) if a period of less than thirty minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on the same length of road
- 4 (1) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable
 - (a) the picking up and setting down of passengers;
 - (b) goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely: -
 - (i) building or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the said roads;
 - (iv) the laying erection alteration or maintenance in or in land adjacent to the said lengths of roads of any sewer, main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;


- (d) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory duties;
 - (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets in the service of a universal service provider
- (2) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes.
- (3) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit the following vehicles to wait: -
- (a) a hackney carriage (as defined in the Town Police Clauses Act 1847) waiting at a duly authorised cab rank;
 - (b) a vehicle waiting on a parking place duly authorised by an Order made under the Act provided that the vehicle is parked in accordance with the provisions of such an Order.
- 5 Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait in the length of road referred to therein.
- 6 The restrictions and prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment
- 7 This Order shall come into operation on 2 April 2007 and may be cited as the Borough Council of Gateshead (Woodside Lane) (Limited Waiting) Order 2007
