TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 10th December 2018 the Borough Council of Gateshead made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 82, 83, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling provisions.

The effect of the Order that comes into force on the 17th December 2018 is to introduce a 20mph zone in 'High View, Shibdon' along the lengths of road listed in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order together with plans and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the information desk on the ground floor of Gateshead Council's Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead NE8 1HH, Monday to Thursday between 8.45am and 5.30pm and Friday between 8.45am and 5.00pm or online at: www.gateshead.gov.uk/trafficschemes (Ref: TS/1085).

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under them has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.

SCHEDULE 1

All sections of the highways as described below and their associated side and back lanes:- Dunns Way, Brantwood Court, Cheviot Close, Crowley Gardens, Hawthorn Road, Haggerstone Mews, Park Avenue, Pickering Drive, Rockmore Road, Simonside Road, Springfield Road, Tynevale Avenue, Whitewell Road, Woodvale Road, Wallington Close, Gibsons Court, Rennison Mews, Low Mill Villas, Robinsons Drive, Massey's View, Betsey Place, Dockendale Place, and Sycamore Road for their full lengths. Maple Road from the junction with Massey's View in a north easterly direction for 69 metres.
