

**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF GATESHEAD
(ROWLANDS GILL AREA, GATESHEAD) (SPEED LIMITS)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 27th March 2019 the Borough Council of Gateshead made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 82, 83, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") by virtue of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling provisions.

The effect of the Order that comes into force on the 8th April 2019 is to:

1. Introduce a 20mph zone along the lengths of road listed in Schedule 1 which excludes the A694 Station Road.
2. Reduce the national speed limit to 40mph on a section of the A694 Linzford Road from a point 22 metres south west of its junction with Holmewood Drive in a generally south westerly direction to the Borough boundary for a distance of 1500 metres.

A copy of the Order together with plans and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be examined at the information desk on the ground floor of Gateshead Council's Civic Centre, Regent Street, Gateshead NE8 1HH, Monday to Thursday between 8.45am and 5.30pm and Friday between 8.45am and 5.00pm or online at: www.gateshead.gov.uk/trafficschemes (Ref: TS/1012).

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under them has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
