Background

- The 2008 Place Survey provides information on people's perceptions of their local area and the local services they receive
- The Place Survey replaces the former BVPI General Survey
- The survey collects information on 18 national indicators for local government
- All local services are covered, i.e. council, police, health services, fire etc.

New Focus

BVPI Surveys

- Focus on council services
- Every 3 years

Place Survey


- Focus on all public services in respondent's local area (within 15-20 minutes walk of their home)
- Every 2 years

Methodology

- Postal survey to a maximum of 6,000 residents
- Random sample of addresses from Royal Mail Postal Address File
- Prescribed questions and timeframe
- Limited additional questions
- Prescribed reminders (x2)


Results – Overall Satisfaction

% of people satisfied with how Gateshead Council runs things overall




How people get on...

NI 1 - % who agree that their local area is a place where people from different backgrounds get on well together




Belonging to a neighbourhood

NI 2 - % of people who feel they belong to their immediate neighbourhood (new indicator)




Involvement in local decisions

NI 3 - % who have been involved in decisions that affect the local area in the past 12 months (new indicator)




Influencing local decisions...

NI 4 & Gateshead Agreement - % who agree that they can influence decisions in their local area




Satisfaction with local area...


NI 6 & Gateshead Agreement - % who have given unpaid help at least once per month over the last 12 months (new indicator)



Anti-social behaviour...


NI 17 & Gateshead Agreement - % who think that anti-social behaviour is a problem in their local area


NI 21 - % who agree that the police and other local public services are successfully dealing with anti-social behaviour and crime in their local area (new indicator)

NI 22*- % who agree that in their local area parents take enough responsibility for the behaviour of their children


*Note: The 2006 BVPI score for how much of a problem is there with parents **not** taking responsibility for their children was 74%


NI 23 - % who think there is a problem with people not treating each other with respect and consideration in their local area

(Note: A lower percentage represents better performance)




Seeking people's views

Feeling informed in an emergency


NI 37 - % who feel informed about what to do in the event of a largescale emergency (new indicator)

NI 41 - % who think that drunk and rowdy behaviour is a problem in their local area




NI 42 - % who think that drug use or drug dealing is a problem in their local area


Self-reported health status

NI 119 - % who say their health is good or very good (new indicator)




Home and neighbourhood
